Himmelbjerget Danish Camp, a program of the Northwest Danish Foundation, offers you a unique opportunity to become more familiar with the delightful little country of Denmark. For one week you will be exposed to Denmark - to its history, people, language, culture, and traditions. At Himmelbjerget Danish Camp, the only Danish camp west of the Mississippi, you will meet new friends and have a memorable time.

WHERE: HIMMELBJERGET Danish Camp will be held at the Menucha Retreat and Conference Center, 22 miles East of Portland, Oregon. Easiest access is from the East-West freeway, Interstate 84. Take the Corbett exit road, Exit 22, to the top of the hill, then left (East) at the Y, and ahead about 1 1/2 miles to the Menucha entrance.

WHEN: June 22 - 28, 2008

FOR WHOM: All 4th through 12th graders (during 2007-2008 school year) who have a special fondness for things that are Danish are welcome to attend. All 4th through 12th graders refers to the grade completed as of Spring 2008.

COST: \$495 if camper provides own bedding; \$505 if bedding is furnished. (Bedding includes blanket, sheets, towels, and pillow.) This includes tuition, food, lodging, and instruction, as well as a Himmelbjerget T-shirt.
